- Be a member of the Crafts Council of Ireland
- Produce work which consistently shows high quality of craftsmanship and exceptional design
- Application to the group is through a selection process. A panel will be looking for high quality innovative work which will compliment the rest of the group. This means that certain disciplines are excluded at certain selections to ensure a good variety of work within the network.
